Graduate Certificate in Addiction Studies

The Certificate in Addiction Studies program is designed for individuals that possess a Master's degree in Counseling, Psychology or Social Work and wish to further specialize in the study of addictions. A 300-hour internship is required for the program.

Individuals completing this program are eligible for certification as an addictions counselor within the state of Michigan (CAAC). The 18 credit hour program generally requires 1 year to complete.

Admission Requirements

The requirements for admission to the non-degree granting Graduate Certificate in Addiction Studies program includes the following: Complete online application <https://apply.udmercy.edu/apply/>, submit official transcripts from all schools attended; a Master's degree in Counseling, Social Work, Psychology or a related field; an autobiographical statement explaining your interests in the profession; one letter of recommendation from a current supervisor or administrator able to speak to your potential in the counseling field and an interview with the Program Director.
